LEADERSHIP ESSENTIALS TRACK

This develops **WHO** you **ARE** as a leader. 3 modules (2 days each). The track helps you discover who God created you to be as a leader, evaluate your effectiveness, and provides tools to grow in leadership.



- Founded on Biblical principles and research based criteria.
- Designed for transformation rather than only information. Format:
 - ✓ Content presentation about a topic.
 - ✓ Assessment to discover how the participant currently functions.
 - ✓ Coaching and workshop experience to process the content & assessments.
 - ✓ Create a strategy with goals.
 - ✓ Participants return to the next seminar for evaluation, processing, coaching and redevelopment as well as training on additional topics.
- 40% teaching, 30% assessments, 30% coaching and interactive learning.
- The participants will build a notebook of personal assessments, training information, plans/strategies/goals to build on for the future.

4. Conflict Style Assessment, 2 hours
5. Functioning as a leader & on a team with assessment, 2 hours
6. Be a healthy leader w/ assessments, 2 hrs

Module Three: (2 day seminar)

1. Evaluate & coach on assignments from first two modules, 2 hrs
2. Personal Integrity, 2 hours
3. Who I am as a leader, 2 hours
Workshop to pull together the track to assess self & plan for the future
4. Introduction to Characteristics of a Healthy Church, 2 hours
5. Church ethics, boundaries & policies, 2 hrs
6. Going forward – what do I do now? 1 hr

The Institute for Servant Leadership emerged from the hearts of the Church of God district leaders from Indiana, Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Pennsylvania. Over the past 23 years the curriculum has changed and evolved, but the focus remains the same: ***to equip Christians to lead and serve effectively in the local church so that the Great Commission will be fulfilled.***

The tracks are taught in two day increments, 12 hours of instruction. These can be customized for a congregation or district.
