


#### **Summer Chapel Services**

#### Leaseholder Reminders

As we begin another camping season here are some reminders for our leaseholders:

- Water Turn-on: Water is turned on by May 1st each year. There is a possibility that all water is on prior to May 1 (this is dependent on weather and any maintenance issues we run into along the way). Please be aware that it's not uncommon for an area that has been turned on to get turned back off in following days when a water leak turns up that needs repaired. So if you come up in April and your water is on, that does not mean it is officially on. There is a chance it could be off in the following days as we are continuing to turn other areas on.
- Leaf Clean-Up: Leaves raked into mower accessible, long narrow piles, removed of sticks. Leaves will be removed by the Camp Staff the beginning of each week in the month of May up to Memorial Day. After Memorial Day weekend any leaves will need to be taken on your own to the leaf pile back beyond the RV overflow.
- Maintenance Requests: If you encounter a water leak, downed tree, or have another maintenance issue that occurs that is camps responsibility, we ask that you contact the office and put a request in with Desirae. This will then get passed on to the maintenance department.
- Policy Updates: All RVs, by physical examination, or by submission of the size, make, model, manufacture, year, and accompanying pictures, must be approved by the camp director prior to the placement on a leased lot. Whitehall Camp Board reserves the right to condemn and demolish any structure that is declared unsafe or structurally unsound by designated and approved inspectors.
- Electric Upgrades: There have been electrical upgrades on rows G&H, I&J, and C&D. Our team has been working hard to complete this job by the time camping season starts. We are elated to tell you that the electric will be back on May 1st!
